QUALIFICATION AND FEES FOR MEMBERSHIP (EXCERPTS FROM BYE LAWS – CLAUSES 3.3 AND 4.0)

3.3 Qualification

3.3.1 Institutional Member

3.3.1.1 An institutional member may be a Company, Society, Association, Educational Institution and Govt. Body interested in the objectives and functions of the Society. An Institutional member shall name an individual as its representative to the Society, which may be changed only by giving a written note by the concerned institute/organization to the Society. He shall be placed in the grade as per his qualification. The Individual membership no. will be the same as the Institutional membership no. with the grade of membership.

3.3.1.2 The official representative shall have the right to be a member of the Governing Body/State/Local Centre. The name of the representative of an institute/organisation shall be mentioned in the Application Form to be submitted to the Governing Body.

3.3.2 Honorary Fellow

3.3.2.1 The Honorary Fellow shall be a renowned person or an individual with outstanding contribution to the art, science and technology of Illuminating Engineering. He shall be proposed by at least 10 (ten) Fellows in writing and shall be elected unanimously by the Governing Body.

3.3.3 Fellow

3.3.3.1 Every candidate for election as a Fellow or for transfer from Member to Fellow shall satisfy the following qualifications.

3.3.3.2 Age

He shall have attained the age of 40 (forty) years on the date of his application for admission or transfer from Member to Fellow.

3.3.3.3 Occupation

He shall be engaged in the field of illuminating engineering in a position of high responsibility or shall have retired from the profession after having held high position before his application for admission or transfer from Member to Fellow.

3.3.3.4 Qualifications

He shall have one of the following qualifications:

a) He shall be at least a graduate or its equivalent in the field of engineering, technology or related disciplines, viz. fine arts, architecture, interior design etc. and shall have a minimum of 15 (fifteen) years experience in a position of responsibility as described as in para 3.3.3.3.

b) He shall have post graduate qualifications and shall occupy a prominent position in the illuminating engineering profession for at least 5 (five) years.

3.3.4 Member

3.3.4.1 Every candidate for election as a Member or for transfer from Associate Member to Member shall possess the following qualifications.

3.3.4.2 Age

He shall have attained the age of 30 (thirty) years on the date of his application for election or transfer.

3.3.4.3 Occupation

He shall have been engaged in a position of responsibility in the design, execution, in the practice or teaching of illumination or in other directly related fields or activities.

3.3.4.4 Qualifications

He shall have one of the following qualifications:

a) He shall be at least a graduate or its equivalent in the field of engineering, technology or related disciplines, (viz. fine arts, architecture, interior design etc.) or a post-graduate and shall have a minimum of 5 (five) years experience in a position of responsibility as described in para 3.3.4.3.

b) He shall be a diploma holder in the field of engineering, technology or related field or a graduate and shall have a minimum of 10 (ten) years experience in a position of responsibility in a reputed organisation in the design or execution or teaching of illuminating engineering.

3.3.5 Associate

3.3.5.1 Every candidate for election as an Associate Member shall possess the following qualifications:

3.3.5.2 Age

He shall have attained the age of 20 (twenty) years on the date of his application for admission.

3.3.5.3 Qualification

He shall have one of the following qualifications:

a) He shall be a graduate from a recognized university and shall have minimum experience of 1 (one) year in the field of illuminating engineering practice or shall be a diploma holder in engineering with 1 (one) year related experience.

b) He shall have minimum experience of 5 (five) years in the various fields of illuminating engineering practice viz, manufacturing, trading, execution etc.

3.3.6. Student

3.3.6.1 A Student member shall be registered in a college or university for study in engineering, science, fine arts, architecture, interior design or other related field.

He shall continue for a maximum period of four years in that class.

4.0 ENTRANCE FEE, TRANSFER FEE AND ANNUAL AND LIFE MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTION

4.1 Every new applicant shall pay an entrance fee and annual/life membership subscription at the current rate for a grade to which he has applied for admission.

4.2 Every candidate desirous of transfer to any grade of membership shall clear all his dues and pay transfer fee and the requisite fees for the grade applied for at the current approved rate at the time of transfer.

4.3 The annual subscription shall be due on the first day of the financial year and payable by the close of the financial year and shall be paid to the concerned State Centre of the Society. Overseas members shall send their subscription to the Registered Office.

Big companies include Large Scale Industries, Corporate Bodies, Utilities and like.

Small companies include Small Scale Industries, Large Trading Houses, Universities, Technical Institutions, Educational Societies, Research Organisations and like.

4.4 Life Member

4.4.1 Any person eligible for admission as member of the Society in an appropriate grade shall be enrolled as a Life Member in that grade by paying a lumpsum amount as given in Table- 1 in lieu of the annual subscription.

Any existing member desirous to become a Life Member in the same grade shall pay the lumpsum amount given in Table-1, but only after he has cleared all his outstanding dues.

4.4.2 Any Life Member desiring a transfer to higher class of membership shall pay the difference of lumpsum subscription for the proposed class and the existing class with appropriate Transfer Fee.
